Community Pool Reopening Rules

IF RULES ARE NOT FOLLOWED – POOLS WILL BE CLOSED

- Pool hours will temporarily changed to 11:00 AM – 7:00 PM.
 - Pool use hours may be modified without notice
- NO guests allowed
- Follow the directions of the Association’s assigned pool monitor, including complying with maximum time for pool use
- Pool occupancy limit will be decreased to 50 perfect - **Maximum Pool Occupancy - 18**
- Spa will remain closed
- Time will be limited to one (1) hour per household
- Any lounge chairs, tables, etc. must be properly distanced
- No large groups or parties allowed. Homeowners from the same household may swim together. Groups will be limited to six (6) or less
- Residents must maintain a six (6) feet separation between swimmers.
- Residents should wear a cloth face covering when traveling through common areas of the property where it may not be possible to maintain physical distancing, include to and from the pool and shared restrooms
- Residents must wash hands frequently with soap and water, cover coughs and sneezes
- Residents who are experiencing symptoms of illness including a fever of 100 F or above, sore throat, runny nose, chills, not feeling well, sneezing, coughing, abdominal pain, or diarrhea must avoid the pool area.
- Residents should bring and use hand sanitizer
- No one will be permitted to use the pool unless that person has signed and returned a COVID-19 pool waiver form to the Association’s management company in the form attached as Exhibit “A”
